PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION ORDER

THIS MATTER came before the Court for hearing on September 8, 2020, on Plaintiffs Mid-Atlantic Military Family Communities LLC and LPC Property Management LLC's Motion for a Preliminary Injunction. All parties, including Defendants Iisha Garcia and Felipe Lopez, were present.

Upon consideration of the evidence, argument, and authorities submitted to the Court, the Court hereby finds that the Plaintiffs have made a proper case for the entry of a Preliminary Injunction; it is therefore

ADJUDGED, ORDERED, and DECREED that Plaintiffs' Motion is GRANTED IN PART and the Defendants Iisha Garcia and Felipe Lopez are hereby ENJOINED, ORDERED, AND RESTRAINED from causing intentional damage to the Plaintiffs' property located at 4959

Cherbourg Road, Virginia Beach, Virginia for forty-five days from the date of the hearing. *All other requested relief is denied at this time. Bae 9/10/2020*

The Court does not rule upon any other issues of law or fact.

Plaintiffs shall post an injunction bond with security in the amount of \$10,000.

Defendants' endorsements are waived by the Court pursuant to VA. SUP. CT. R. 1:13.
