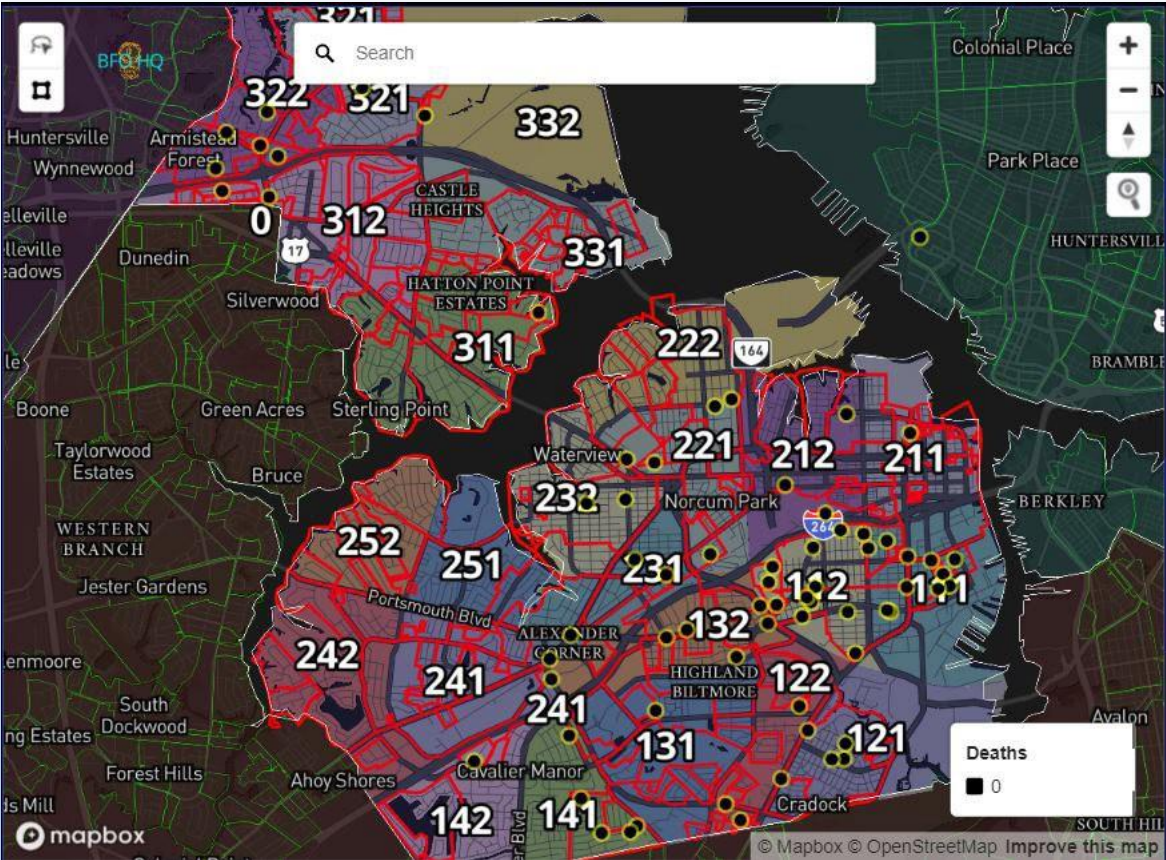

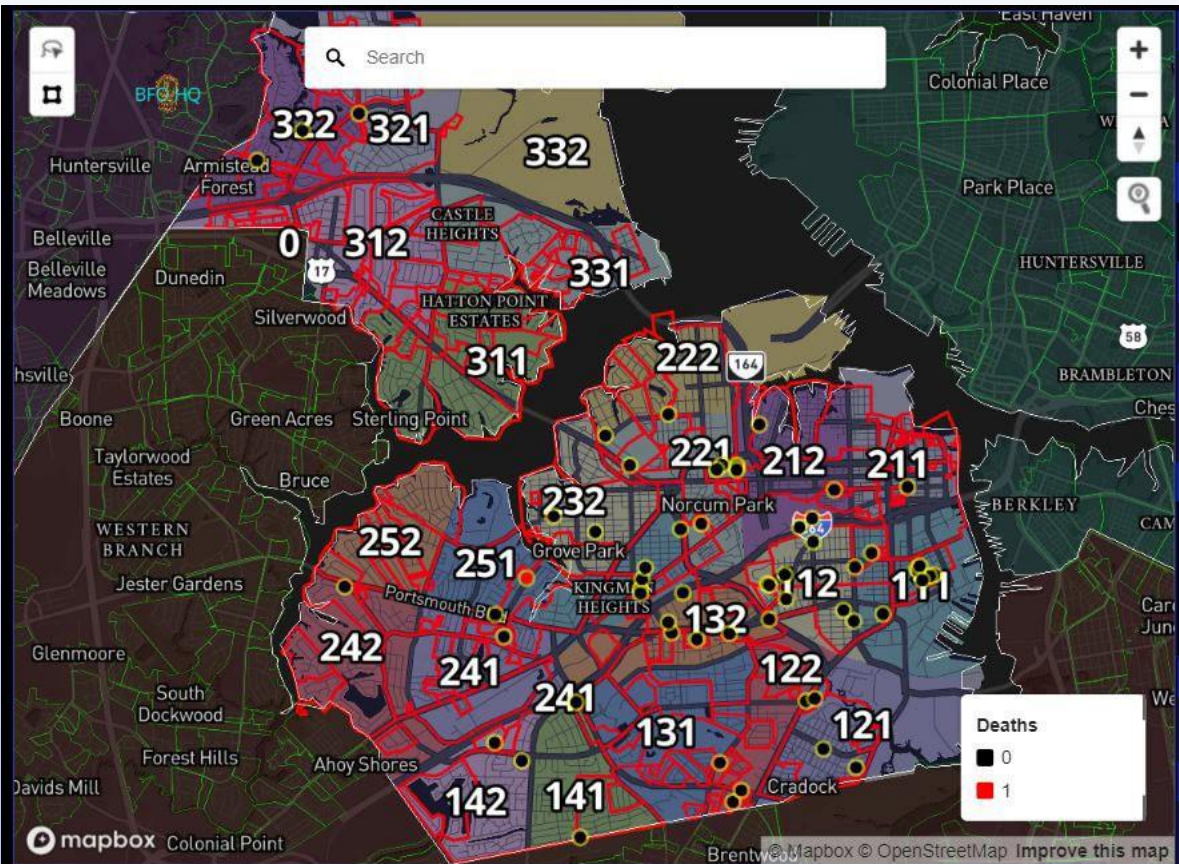

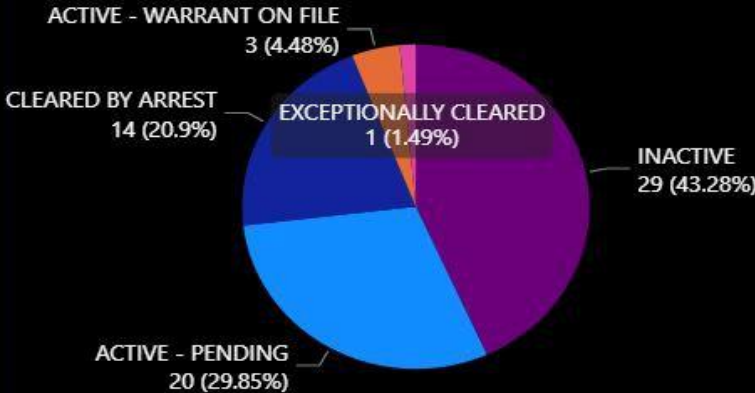


GSW Victims - Injuries/Deaths & Rate
