PLEA AGREEMENT

THIS DAY CAME the parties in interest and represented to the Court that they have entered into the following Plea Agreement in accordance with Rule 3A:8(c).

- 1. The Defendant stands charged in this Court for the following offenses:
 - a. 1 violation of Va. Code § 18.2-32: Second Degree Murder VC Code: MUR-0935-F9
 - b. 2 violations of Va. Code § 18.2-53.1: Use Firearm in Commission of Felony VC Code: ASL-1319-F9
 - c. 1 violation of Va. Code § 18.2-51: Malicious Wounding VC Code: ASL-1334-F3
 - d. 1 violation of Va. Code § 18.2-95(iii): Larceny of Firearm VC Code: LAR-2383-F9
 - e. 2 violations of Va. Code § 18.2-308.2(A): Possess Firearm as a Convicted Felon VC Code: WPN-5291-F6
- 2. The Defendant agrees to plead guilty to the following offenses:
 - a. 1 violation of Va. Code § 18.2-95(iii): Larceny of Firearm VC Code; LAR-2383-F9
 - b. 1 violation of Va. Code § 18.2-308.2(A): Possess Firearm as a Convicted Felon VC Code: WPN-5291-F6 (offense date September 24, 2023).
- 3. The Commonwealth will move to *nolle prosequi* the charges recited in Paragraphs 1(a), 1(b), and 1(c). This motion is a product of the information and evidence available to the Commonwealth and is not made in exchange for the Defendant's plea to other charges.
- 4. In exchange for the defendant's guilty plea, the Commonwealth will move to *nolle* prosequi the charge of Possess Firearm as a Convicted Felon with an offense date of December 20, 2023.
- 5. The parties agree that the appropriate disposition of this matter is that the Court will order the preparation of a presentence investigation report in accordance with the provisions of Va. Code § 19.2-299 and discretionary sentencing guidelines in accordance with the provisions of § 19.2-298.01. After reviewing the report and guidelines and entertaining any additional relevant information presented at a sentencing hearing, the Court will exercise its sole discretion to determine an appropriate sentence.
- 6. This agreement does not require the Defendant to testify at the trial of either of his co-defendants. However, should the Defendant give truthful testimony in those related trials, the Commonwealth will provide an accurate account for the Court's consideration along

with the other information at sentencing.

- 7. This Plea Agreement is the total agreement between the parties. There have been no other inducements, promises, threats or coercion of any kind imposed upon the Defendant nor suggested to the Defendant by the Attorney for the Commonwealth or any agent of the Commonwealth.
- 8. The Defendant agrees not to file any appeal, attack, or motion in this case except by agreement with the Commonwealth. Should the Defendant file any such appeal, attack, or motion this agreement may be made null and void on the motion of the Commonwealth.
- 9. The Commonwealth has complied with Virginia Code § 19.2-11.01(A)(4)(d) through informing the victim of the proposed plea and obtaining the victim's view about the disposition of the case.
- 10. In this case, a previous Plea Agreement has not been submitted to a Judge of this Court.
- 11. The defendant is pleading guilty because he is, in fact, guilty.
- 12. By signing below, the Defendant certifies under penalty of perjury that the date of birth and social security number on the indictments in this case are true and accurate.
